



Cargo box

General recommendations

- Check the cargo box occasionally to make sure everything is in place.
- Make sure the vehicle can support the weight of the cargo box and its contents.
- Before starting the vehicle, make sure that the mount is securely fastened, that the cargo box doors are locked and if applicable, that the bicycles are secured with a lock. Do not take the road until the cargo box is closed and well fixed.
- Vehicle handling might vary due to the cargo box. Avoid driving at excessive speed, especially on bumpy roads. The trunk is an additional load, and could hit road elements like speed bumpers, sidewalks, loading platforms, railroads, etc., which could result in damage to the vehicle, the cargo box or its components. Before taking the road, always make sure the cargo box is firmly fixed.
- Respect the maximum load capacity of the cargo box, which is 200 lbs, including the bicycles. Also, the total weight of the bicycles must not exceed 120 lbs. Be sure to properly distribute the load inside the cargo box.
- If the cargo box does not have a bike rack, or there are no bicycles on the rack, the maximum load can be up to 200 lbs.
- NICOVA guarantees the proper functioning of the cargo box's electrical system. However, if it is not compatible with the one of the vehicle; an adapter may be necessary.
- Before any trip, the straps and screws must be well fixed and tighten. Along the way, inspect them regularly. If they show signs of wear, replace them before using the cargo box again .
- The cargo box is waterproof and watertight: in case of water infiltration problem, check the rubbers and replace them if necessary.
- Do not keep fragile or valuable items in the cargo box: in case of a sudden stop, they could hit the walls and result in damages. NICOVA is not responsible for any damages of this nature.
- Please follow the instructions provided by NICOVA each time you use the cargo box, as you are the only person responsible for its installation and use.
- Dirt and dust can damage the finish of the cargo box; it is therefore recommended to remove and store it when it's not used.

Maintenance and cleaning

- The cargo box can be cleaned and waxed with automotive cleaning products. If it was to tarnish, it can be polished with fiberglass maintenance products.
